Open burning ban lifted for Sun Prairie Fire District

*****Effective Immediately*****

The open burning ban that was in effect as a result of COVID-19 has been lifted, and open burning may resume under normal open burning rules and procedures.

For the Townships of Burke, Bristol, and Sun Prairie, all open burns must be called in to our open burning voicemail (608) 837-5066, and please listen carefully to the instructions.

Campfires, “fire pits” and/or cooking fires do NOT require an open burning permit.



As always; safe and responsible burning is your responsibility. Below are some tips for safe and responsible open burning:

- Only natural (untreated) wood or regular yard waste (grass, leaves, brush, etc...) is permitted to be burned
- Garbage, furniture, construction material, plastics, shingles or any other refuse materials are strictly prohibited from being burned. Failure to comply will result in citation
- **ALWAYS keep a water source nearby and Call 911 immediately if the fire becomes uncontrolled**
- Do NOT burn on windy days, and always be mindful of where the smoke will go. A little common sense and consideration of others goes a long way
