#### SEC. 2-1-1 LEGAL STATUS; GENERAL TOWN POWERS.

- (a) The Town of Burke is a body corporate and politic, with those powers granted by law. The Town shall be designated in all actions and proceedings by its name, as the Town of Burke.
- (b) The Town may:
  - (1) Sue and be sued.
  - (2) Acquire and hold real and personal property for public use and convey and dispose of the property.
  - (3) Enter into contracts necessary for the exercise of its corporate powers.

#### SEC. 2-1-2 VILLAGE POWERS.

The Town Meeting having, by resolution, directed the Town Board to exercise all powers relating to villages and conferred on village boards by Chapter 61, Wis. Stats.,

the Town shall have said powers through its Board. This is a continuing grant of powers.

**SEC. 2-1-3 VOTER REGISTRATION.**

- (a) Pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 6.27(2) of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Town of Burke elects that registration shall be required for all primaries and elections in the Town of Burke.
- (b) The Town Clerk of the Town of Burke shall forthwith certify this action to the County Clerk and to the Secretary of State.

**SEC. 2-1-4 POLLING PLACE.**

The polling place serving all wards in the Town of Burke shall be the Burke Town Hall.

**SEC. 2-1-5 ELECTION POLL HOURS; WORKERS.**

- (a) The voting polls in the Town of Burke, Dane County, Wisconsin, shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. for all elections.
- (b) The Town Clerk is authorized to determine the number of poll workers needed on election days.

**SEC. 2-1-6 OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER.**

The Town of Burke shall use posting pursuant to the Wisconsin Statutes as its means of giving notice. When publication is required by the Wisconsin Statutes or when directed by the Town Board, the official newspaper of the Town of Burke shall be The Star, published in Sun Prairie, Wisconsin.
