Vending Machines

7-8-1 Vending Machine Permits

SEC. 7-8-1 VENDING MACHINE PERMITS.

- (a) **Definitions.** The following shall be applicable in this Section:
- (1) "Vending Machine" means any self-service device offered for public use, which, upon insertion of a coin or token or by other means, dispenses bottled, prepackaged or canned soft drinks, candy, gum, nuts, nut meats, cookies, crackers, prepackaged Grade A pasteurized milk or milk products or cigarettes and one cent vending devices. "Vending machine" does not include self-service devices which dispense unit servings of food or beverages either in bulk or package for which a permit from the Wisconsin Department of Health and Social Services is required under Section 50.51, Wis. Stats.
- (b) **Permit Required.** No person may maintain, manage or operate a vending machine or make a vending machine available for public use if the person has not requested and obtained an annual permit from the Town Board for each such vending machine. The annual permit period shall run from July 1st to the following June 30th.
- (c) **Permit Fee.** The fee for obtaining an annual permit for each vending machine shall be Ten Dollars (\$10.00).
