## FINAL RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN OF BURKE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT AND LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENT AGAINST BENEFITTED REINER ROAD PROPERTIES

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Town of Burke, Wisconsin, held a public hearing at the Town Hall at 5:30 p.m. on May 17, 2023 for the purpose of hearing all interested persons concerning the preliminary resolution and report of the Reiner Road public improvements consisting of replacement of asphalt and culverts, ditch grading, minor curb replacement, minor erosion control, minor signage, and pavement striping. And preliminary assessments against benefitted property and heard all persons who desired to speak at the hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the governing body of the Town of Burke, Wisconsin, determines as follows:

- 1. The report of the Reiner Road Special Assessment, a copy of which is attached here-to and incorporated herein as if fully set forth herein, including the plans and specifications and assessments set forth therein, is adopted and approved.
- 2. The Town Engineer, Mead & Hunt, shall supervise construction of the improvements in accordance with the report hereby adopted.
- 3. Payment for improvements shall be made by assessing the full cost to the property benefitted as indicated in the report.
- 4. The Town Board declares its intention to exercise its powers pursuant to Section 66.0703 Wis. Stats., to levy special assessment to property owners for benefits accruing from the reconstruction of Reiner Road.
- 5. The total amount assessed for such improvements against each property shall not exceed the total cost of the improvements to the Town, together with interest on any amount unpaid after the initial assessment year.
- 6. Assessments for all projects included in the report are hereby combined as a single assessment but any interested property owner may object to each assessment separately or ass assessments jointly for any purpose.
- 7. Assessments shall be paid within thirty (30) days of receiving the invoice from the Town or in ten (10) annual installments to the Town Clerk/Treasurer. Installments shall be placed on the next tax roll after the due date for collection and shall bear interest at the rate of 2% per annum on the unpaid balance from the due date. Installments or assessments not paid when due shall bear additional interest on the amount due at the rate of 1.5% per annum.
- 8. The Municipal Clerk shall publish this resolution as a class I notice under ch.985, Stats., in the assessment district and mail a copy of this resolution and a statement of the final assessment against the benefitted property together with notice4 of installment payment privileges to every property owner whose name appears on the assessment roll whose post office address is known or can with reasonable diligence be ascertained.

The above Resolution was duly adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Burke, Dane County, Wisconsin, at a meeting on May 17, 2023.
