There will be two Town Supervisor positions on the ballot in April along with the Presidential Preference.


In-Person absentee voting will be March 19—March 29 at the Town Hall between 9:00 am—4:00 pm Monday -Thursday, 9:00—noon on Friday March 22, and 9:00 am—5:00 pm Friday March 29 for the Spring Election.

Please take a moment and check your voter information on the statewide MyVote.wi.gov website.

Beginning in 2023 the Town of Burke moved from paper poll books to electronic poll books called *Badger Books*.

Why are Badger Books being used?

- Improved wait times for voters: Poll workers no longer search through a large book to find your name and poll books are no longer divided by last name.
- Efficient voter registration on Election Day: Paper registration forms are no longer completed on Election Day; proof of residency is still required to register.
- Efficient absentee ballot processing on Election Day: Poll workers scan a bar code on the envelope containing the absentee ballot to locate the voter and assign a voter number instead of using a large book to look for each voter.
- Voter participation statistics available faster on myvote.wi.gov. The time for Clerks to record voter participation after an election is drastically reduced.
- Are Badger Books connected to the internet? Badger Books are not connected to the internet. Badger Books in each polling place have a secure connection with each other but are unable to connect to the internet or any other network outside of the polling place. Yard Waste

Pellitteri Waste Systems will pick up residential yard waste once again. They will be picking up at your road side beginning the week of April 22, May 28, June 17, July 8, September 3, October 21, and November 18, 2024.

Yard waste should be placed roadside in reusable plastic containers no larger than 30 gallons or compostable paper bags. If plastic bags are used, they should be left open and not tied. Plastic bags are not preferred and may be left after emptying.

Please have your yard waste out by 6:00 a.m. on the first day of the scheduled pickup. Pellitteri will be making one trip through the Town.

Brush

Barnes Inc. remains the Town's contracted brush removal company. Please have your residential brush to the roadside by 7:00 a.m. the first Monday of May (6th), July (1st), September (3rd), and November (4th). Barnes will be making one trip through the Town.

Brush will be limited to material 10 feet in length and not to exceed 6 inches in diameter. Pile size can not exceed 4'X4'X10' in size. One pile per home. Barnes will not pickup tree roots, root balls, stumps or other logs larger than 6 inches in diameter. Material left by someone other than homeowner will not be collected.

<u>Campfires and cooking fires</u> are allowed without a permit but open burning of leaves and brush requires a permit. To obtain a permit, call 608-837-5066, ext. #4.

Spring Clean Up

The Town of Burke Spring Clean Up will be Saturday **May 18** at the Town Hall between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and noon.

This event is offered for the convenience of Town residents to dispose of incidental items. Town Staff and Town Officials will be on site to assist residents.

Items accepted: Furniture, mattresses, small auto parts, carpet, small freon free appliances, toilets and sinks, fluorescent bulbs, dry cell, rechargeable, and small electronic batteries, lawn mowers, refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, etc.

<u>Resource Solutions</u> is providing a dumpster for electronics such as TVs, monitors, computers, printers, etc. See Town website for fees charged. Cash only, no change given.

<u>Not Accepted:</u> constructions materials, stone, gravel, tires, tree parts, yard waste, or any hazardous waste.
